Public vs. Private

§Funded from taxes paid to local and state governments by residents of the state.

§Designed to educate residents of the state. (Often Called "Flag-Ship" or State Universities).

§Usually offer a wide variety of majors

§Funded by tuition.

§Students often come from all parts of the world.

§May be a bit more specialized; limited majors Campus size is smaller; emphasis on community
