Harker will utilize the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Santa Clara County health department recommendations for school response and closures and in the identification of risk level. In the absence of local closures and quarantines, the following categories identify potential risk levels.

Level 1 - Low Risk

No Harker community cases of COVID-19
A low level of cases in the adjoining area
No declaration of a public health emergency in the United States
Airports implementing informal screening mechanisms
Travel advisories to/from specific countries in place

Level 2 - Moderate Risk

No students, faculty or staff sick with COVID-19
A limited level of cases in the adjoining area
Increased number of travel advisories to/from specific countries in place
No advisories against non-essential travel to Northern California
Travel bans from outside countries in place
WHO/CDC/County has declared COVID-19 a pandemic

Level 3 - Medium Risk

A case of COVID-19 within the Harker community
Increased count of cases in the adjoining area
Increased number of travel restrictions – airlines, public transport
COVID-19 disease behavior or contagiousness goes to higher risk level
