- PLEASE REMAIN PATIENT




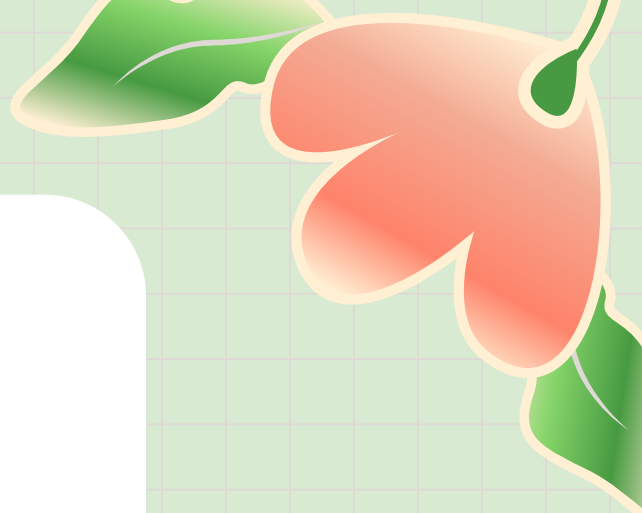
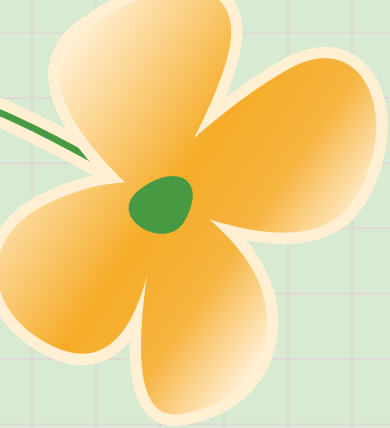
