COVID-19 As We Start the Year

- Vaccination rates are very high schoolwide
- Rapid tests are easy to get and very accurate
- Nurses will test students who have symptoms of COVID-19



What If the Test is Positive?

- Mandatory five days of isolation.
- Counting starts with Day 0: the day symptom(s) began or the day of the positive test (whichever came first).
- Students may return without further testing on Day 6 if:
 - symptoms are resolving
 - they are fever-free for 24 hours
 - feeling well enough to participate in learning
- Masks must be worn on Days 6-10

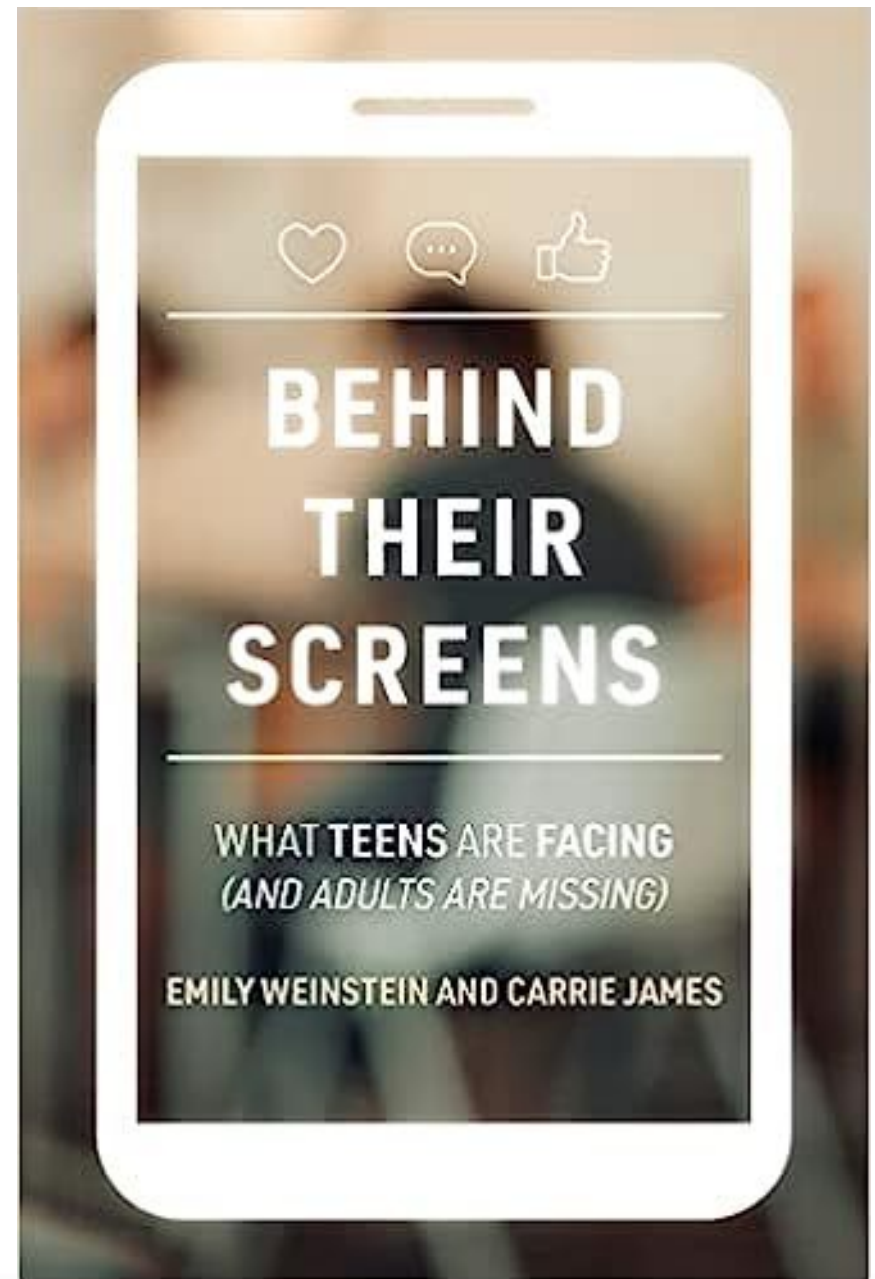

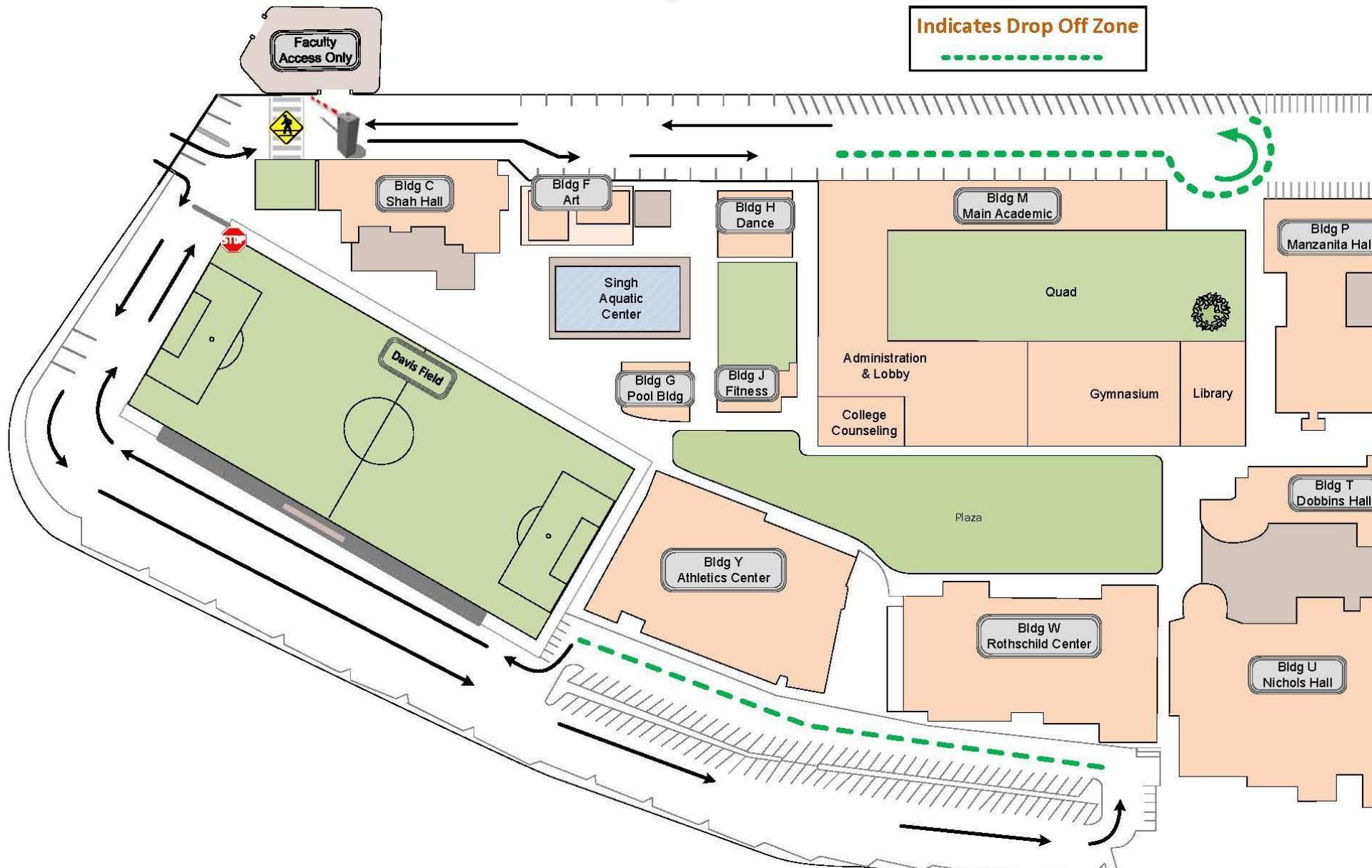

- Be kind.

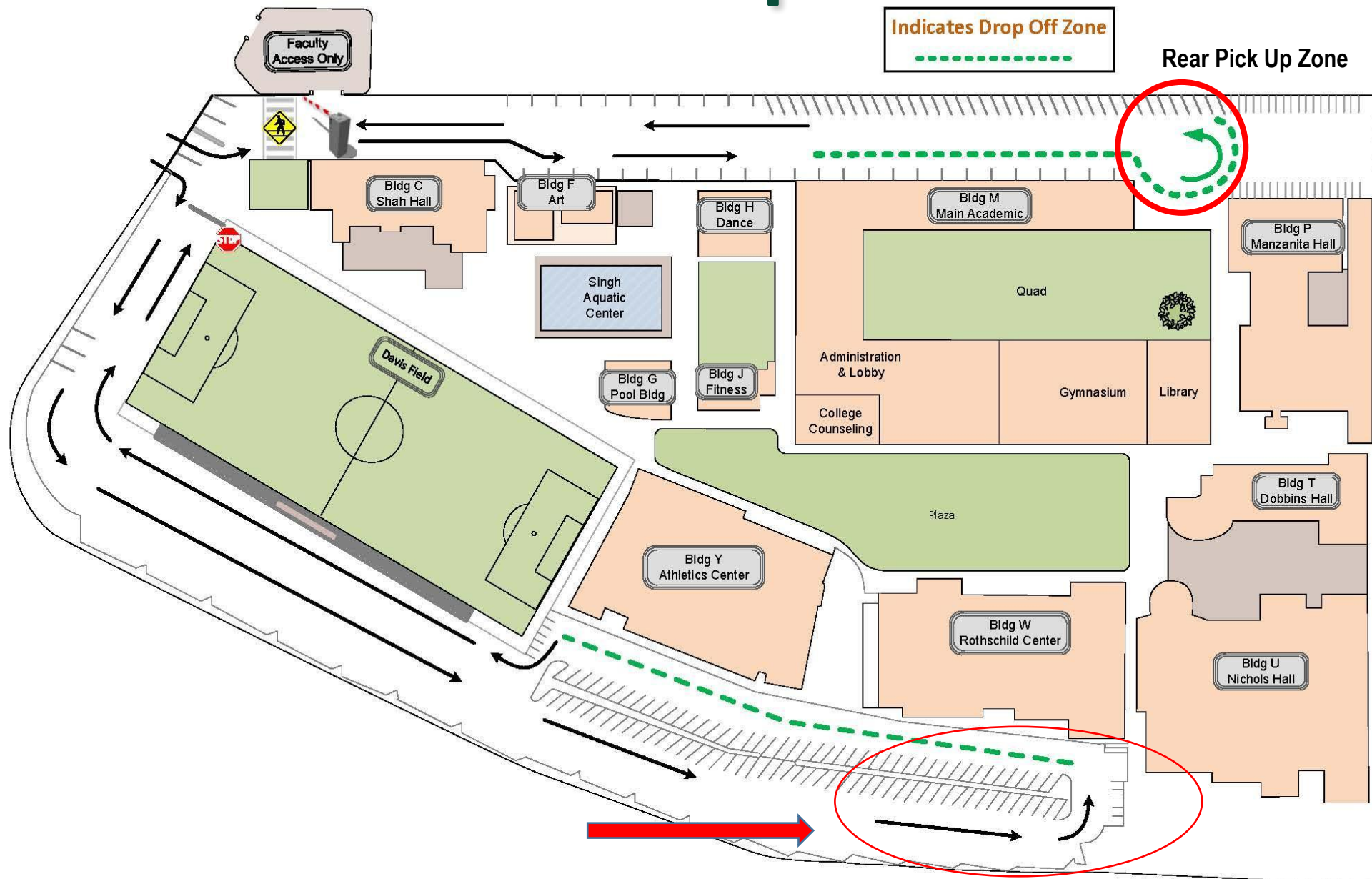

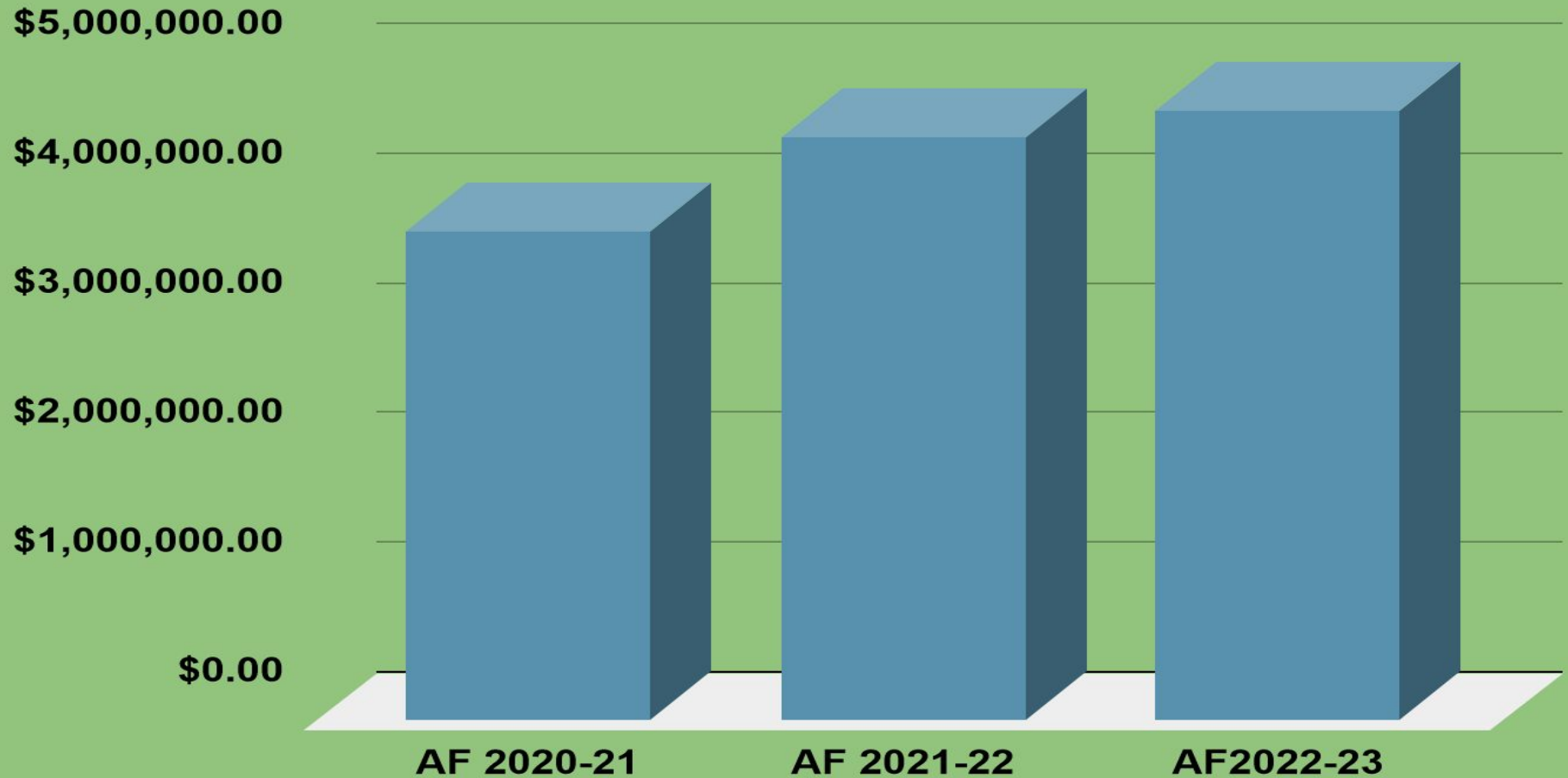
