BASE PROGRAM AND LATE SUPERVISION

The following important information appears in your student/parent handbook. We are repeating it here for your convenience:

AFTER-SCHOOL ENRICHMENT

The after-school enrichment supervision and various activities are available to all students as a part of their tuition. Students are offered a variety of daily drop-in activities or may sign up for scheduled workshops. This program runs on a four-session system which is different than the academic semester system.

- **Drop-in:** These activities do not require a registration form. Students can choose to stop by any time. ClubBASE, table tennis, Act. Ave, Fun Fridays, amp activities, and library.
- **Enrichment Class:** Registration is required. Most BASE workshops are free, but some require a supply fee. Photoshop, candle making, food science, music writing and recording, and journalism plus many more are offered.
- **Specialty:** These classes are provided by private organizations and therefore require registration and an additional fee. All fees are charged to your Harker account. Coding, private music lessons (guitar or piano), babysitting safety, and other great classes may be offered.

Grade 6-8 students are asked to communicate with their parents regarding afternoon pickup times and locations. All students must remain in a supervised area of the campus. Detailed information on daily procedures will be provided online before school begins.

Other Notes

- For the first quarter, the after-school enrichment packet information is emailed home and posted on the Parent Portal under the "Middle School After School" orange tab.
- Prior to the start of the remaining quarters, information will be posted on the Parent Portal under MS Daily Life with a link to the MS BASE after school tab on the homepage.
- Class capacities are limited, so we encourage students to enroll as soon as possible.
- Classes require a minimum enrollment and may be cancelled because of low enrollment.



FALL SIGN-UPS

An email will be sent in early August from the directors of BASE, giving information on when and how to register for Session 1 classes.

LATE SUPERVISION

The Union campus closes each day at 6 p.m. Students who are not picked up by 6 p.m. will be charged for extended care based on the following:

The charge will be \$10 for every 15 minutes starting at 6 p.m., with a \$1 per minute fee. At 6:15, per minute fee increases to \$2. Beginning at 7 p.m., the charges increase to \$30 for every 15 minutes.

Example:

6:18=\$41
6:36=\$87
7:05= \$185
