- Grade 7 and 8 Ambassadors visit grade 6 advisories to assist in the transition.

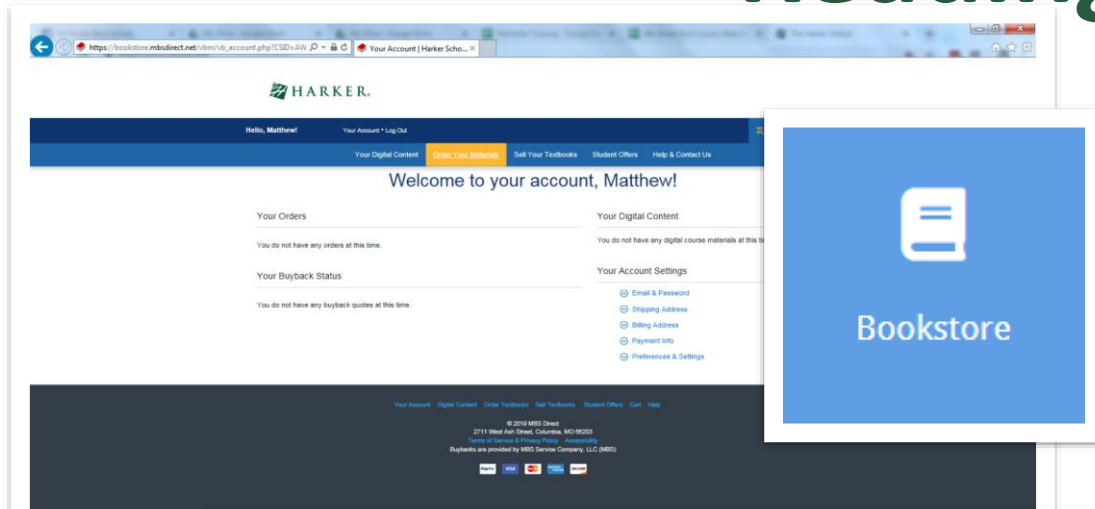


# Advisory

- Advisories meet twice a week with a focus on character growth and social-emotional development, community activities, and group bonding.

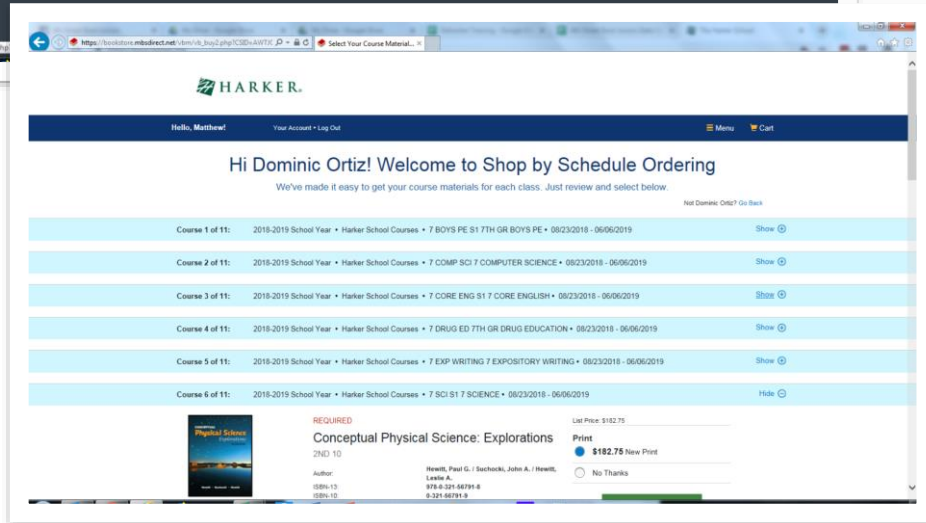
