
Here's a quick guide to help you find needed information and helpful resources!

1 Harker Parent Portal

This is a password-protected portal on the Harker website where your family's information can be updated, and useful links, downloads, contact information, photo galleries and news can be found. Each parent has a unique login and password.


Portal Access

Member Login


Log in to access the parent portal and your personal account.



Parent Portal Home and Tabs

The parent portal home page contains recent announcements, resources and links to various schoolwide pages such as the calendar, your family & student info, and, for lower school, your group spaces ("My Groups"), where you can access teacher pages and homework.

Each of these color "tiles" are moveable so you can rearrange them in whatever order best suits your needs. Just grab the "hamburger" icon in the upper left of the tile and drag it where you would like it.

The Performing Arts tile links you to a page where you can access all performance videos for free, and see the performing arts calendar and ticket links.



2 Harker eWeekly

Sent each Thursday night to all families, the eWeekly contains key date reminders for the coming week. It also includes upcoming events, top news links for that week and any updates posted in the portal. The eWeekly is designed to be a helpful “at-a-glance” tool for our busy parents.



3 Harker News Express (Monthly)

The Harker News Express is emailed on the first school day of each month to all families and to alumni. It recaps the top stories from the previous month, and includes event reminders for the coming month.
